A 32 bar Strathspey for 4 couples in a four-couple longwise set.

Lead tune: The Falkirk Bairn, by Gordon Shand

Suggested recording: *The Falkirk Bairn*, Gordon Shand and his Scottish Dance Band (Reels and Wheels)

<u>Bars</u> 1 – 4	Description  1 <sup>st</sup> and 4 <sup>th</sup> couples turn partner with both hands finishing back in place.
4 – 8	1 <sup>st</sup> couple with 2 <sup>nd</sup> couple and 4 <sup>th</sup> couple with 3 <sup>rd</sup> couple set and link.
9 – 12	1 <sup>st</sup> and 4 <sup>th</sup> couple dance four hands around to the left finishing with both hands joined with their partner in the middle of the dance ready for
13 – 16	1 <sup>st</sup> and 4 <sup>th</sup> couples dance a half strathspey poussette.
17 – 20	2 <sup>nd</sup> couple with 4 <sup>th</sup> couple and 1 <sup>st</sup> couple with 3 <sup>rd</sup> couple four hand around to the left finishing with both hand joined with their partner in the middle of the dance ready for
21 – 24	2 <sup>nd</sup> couple with 4 <sup>th</sup> couple and 1 <sup>st</sup> couple with 3 <sup>rd</sup> couple dance half strathspey poussette.

Repeat bars 1 - 8 from opposite ends of the dance

Repeat from new positions.

25 - 32
