	places while 3 <sup>rd</sup> and 4 <sup>th</sup> couples dance rights and lefts
17~20	1st couple dance in and cast off to fourth place; 2nd, 3rd and 4th couples,
	taking hands, step up on bars 19-20
21~24	1st couple, giving right hands, turn once round to finish facing down in
	promenade hold (woman on man's left side); 3rd and 4th couples step in
	to face down in promenade hold on bar 24
25~32	3rd, 4th and 1st couples dance a promenade down anticlockwise

Repeat with a new top couple.
