Reel 32 bars, 3 couples in a 4 couple set I would like: Breckin lassies

- Bars 1 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> couples set and, pulling back by the right cast clockwise for 4 bars, halfway around. On bar 7 and 8 2<sup>nd</sup> and 1<sup>st</sup> couples cross to own side giving right hand. 2<sup>nd</sup> couple finish facing in and down, 1<sup>st</sup> couple facing out ready for
- Bars 9 2<sup>nd</sup> 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> couple dance a 8 bar right shoulder reel of 3 on own side. 1<sup>st</sup> lady starts by dancing out and down, 1<sup>st</sup> man out and up, 2<sup>nd</sup> couple dancing in and down. 1<sup>st</sup> couple finish giving right hand to 1<sup>st</sup> corner and left hand to partner, ready for:
- Bars 17 1<sup>st</sup> couple balance in line with 1<sup>st</sup> corners. 1<sup>st</sup> couple turn (4 bars) each other 1 and 1/4 with left hand. Finish giving right hand to 2<sup>nd</sup> corner and balance in line with 2<sup>nd</sup> corner.
- Bars 25 1<sup>st</sup> man with 2<sup>nd</sup> couple and 1<sup>st</sup> lady with 3<sup>rd</sup> couple dance a 6 bar, left shoulder to 3<sup>rd</sup> corner, reel of 3 across the dance.1<sup>st</sup> couple finish by crossing to 2<sup>nd</sup> place own side ready to start again.
