4 X 32 bars strathspey
Dance in 4 couple sets.
Progression in the dance
Tune used: Dalkeith Strathspey

- Bar
- 1- 4 1c+2c 3c+4c set and link
- 5- 8 1c+4c circle half way to the left ending inside the set, 1c facing up 4c facing down
1c+4c set
Meanwhile 2c+3c turn right hand for 4 bars
- 9-10 1c make an arch with nearer hands.
1c+4c change place (4c dive under)
- 11-12 1c+4c turn 2 hands (ending facing top/bottom)
- 13-16 1c+4c dance out top/bottom, cast round corners and end in the middle facing corner
- 17-20 All 4 couples dance Glasgow highland step. Right and left.
But the center persons turn r+l in the Glasgow highland step
- 21-22 1c+4c turn corners with nearer hands for 2 bars
- 23-24 1c+4c chase round half way anticlockwise 2 places (back to own side)
Ending 2-4-1-3
- 25-32 2c+4c and 3c+1c full diamond poussette
- 2nd tour ends 4-3-2-1
3rd tour ends 3-1-4-2
4th tour ends 1-2-3-4
