WE'VE NAE ELECTRIC

32 bar Reel for 5 couples.

Bars	
1-4	1 st and 3 rd couples cross over; 1 st lady to face 2 nd and 4 th men, 3 rd lady to face 4 th and 5 th men and 1 st man to face 2 nd and 4 th ladies, 3 rd man to face 4 th and 5 th ladies. 2 nd and 4 th couples step up on Bars 1-2. All 5 couples join hands as in double triangles and set.
5-8	1 st and 3 rd couples dance round their first corners into the middle of the dance, men facing up and ladies facing down, ready for:
9-16	Reel of four in the middle of the dance while, at the same time, 2 nd 4 th and 5 th couples dance a left shoulder reel of three on the sidelines; to begin the 4 th lady dances in and down and the 4 th man dances in and up. All finish the reels where they began.
17-20	1 st and 3 rd couples cross giving right hands and cast round to their right ie:
	1 st lady dances round 4 th man and 1 st Man dances round 2 nd lady to finish in second place on opposite sides of the dance 3 rd lady dances round 5 th man and 3 rd man dances round 4 th lady to finish in fourth place on opposite sides of the dance.
21-24	1 st and 3 rd couples turn with the right hand one and a half times to own sides of the dance
25-28	1 st and 4 th couples and 3 rd and 5 th couples set and link.
29-32	All five couples turn with the right hand once round. Finish 2, 4, 1, 5, 3

Repeat from new positions.
