COMPLIMENTS TO JESSIE BAIN

32 Bar Strathspey for 4 couples

1 st and 2 nd couples, 3 rd and 4 th couples dance half rights and lefts.
1 st lady and 2 nd man, 3 rd lady and 4 th man change places giving right hands. 1 st man and 2 nd lady, 3 rd man and 4 th lady change places giving left hands. 1 st and 3 rd couples finish facing down and 2 nd and 4 th couples finish facing up, ready for:
Reels of four on the side lines. Begin by passing right shoulder with the person facing.
1 st couple set and cast off one place; 2 nd couple step up on bars 19-20.
1 st and 3 rd couples dance four hands once round to the left.
1 st couple, with nearer hands joined, dance down between 3 rd couple, divide and cast round 4 th couple to finish in 4 th place; 3 rd and 4 th couples step up on bars 27-28.
All turn partners with the right hand once round.

Repeat with a new top couple.

Devised by Jean Mair, for her sister, Jessie Bain. This dance was the winner of a competition organised by the Banffshire Branch for their 60th Anniversary in 1989.

Jessie Bain was Pianist at the Buckie Class, and various other classes, for many years and was a recipient of the Society's Scroll in 1986.
